#### DR. JOHN M. CONRAD

John Conrad and his wife Joie reside in Eskdale, Utah, where they have been among the leadership of the House of Aaron community for many years. John is the veterinarian for House of Aaron, having earned his DVM from the University of California at Davis in 1976. In addition to his veterinary work, John is a teacher, writer, and shepherd of the Eskdale community, which has been in existence since 1955. Recently John described the purpose of House of Aaron by saying, "Our passion and mission is to assist in the gathering of Israel into a Holy Nation with Yeshua as King and the Torah (Word) as its constitution. Our focus is on Yeshua." Because of his knowledge and experience in building and maintaining a faith-based community, John was asked to address the First B'ney Yosef National Congress on the subject of community and national unity. Joie is an active intercessor, having served with such Christian organizations as Aglow International, and is a gifted worship dancer. John and Joie have six children and are grandparents of eight.

### DR. IGLAHLIQ SUUQIINA – INDIGENOUS MESSENGERS INTERNATIONAL

Suugiina was born in Nome, Alaska. He is of Inuit, Mi'Kmag, English, Scottish, Irish, and French descent. He is the Grandson of Chief Suugiina of King Island Alaska and his mother was a full-blood Inuit. When he was 7, he and his biological brother were adopted by the missionaries and moved to Minnesota, where they remained until he was 18. As a young adult in college, Suugiina, was drawn to Native American studies, where he connected to his lost culture. For a few years, he traveled as a keyboard player with a rock band where he had a transformative experience with Yeshua that altered his life"D5s path. He felt called to live as a preacher of the Word of God and served as a pastor for 21 years. Suuqiina returned to Alaska and reconnected to his native culture and people. He became involved in reconciliation work and multiculturalism, teaching on protocol and the restoration of indigenous instruments and values for the purpose of worship and following Yeshua. His work also enabled him to conduct reconciliation meetings in Far East Russia and in Brazil as well as

a Gatekeeper for Grand Chief Lynda Prince and the 120 Drums, Suuqiina was privileged to travel to Israel and stand before the Knesset and Avram Berg with other Native American Chiefs and leaders. Through this Israel connection he met and married Qaumaniq and joined her as the North American Representative to a messianic ministry in Tel Aviv, which she had been serving at the time of their marriage. Suuqiina also participates as a featured artist many galleries and centers, including The Alaska Federation of Natives annual conference, and The Peabody Museum in Massachusetts. His membership includes: The Native American Indian Arts and Crafts Association, The Silver Hands-Made in Alaska Artist Association, The Oil Painters of America, and The Portrait Society.

#### **Ed Boring**

Ed and Wendy Boring met while participating in a youth musical – "Show Me! Jesus!" – in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in 1972. When the summer musical season was over, they joined several other young people in founding a singing group called "Rebound." In December 1973, they were married at Sandia Baptist Church, in Albuquerque. In 1977, Ed graduated from Fresno Pacific College with a pastoral degree.
