Meal of Remember in the House of the Beloved

Preparation For A Greater Exodus

Introduction:

LEADER-

Many generations ago, the Nation of Yisrael was held in captive slavery in Mitsrayim.

The sons and daughters of Yisrael cried out to YHWH their Elohim, praying for their deliverance from bitterness of struggle and slave labor. They yearned for freedom and the ability to return to the days when they had plenty of everything. They longed for the time when they were accepted and respected in the Mitsrite society and enjoyed a peaceful and happy life. But there was a greater need. Am Yisrael needed to be reconnected to their roots, to their real identity, and to their fathers; Avraham, Yitzchak, and Ya'acov. They needed to find their destiny outside of their current society and environment and realize that they were in fact living in Exile; that they held claim through their roots, to an inheritance reserved just for them.

YHWH heard their cry and sent to them Moshe, who was given signs of power, in order to go to Pharaoh and demand that he let Yisrael go. YHWH's desire was not to return Yisrael to a place of acceptance and happiness inside Mitsrayim, but to lead them out and bring them to the Land of Promise; Eretz Yisrael. During the journey He would transform them from slaves to men and women of His Covenant, by giving to them the Torah and by revealing His Presence to them at Har [Mount] Sinai.

YHWH demonstrated His Plagues and mighty signs; the revelation of His Mighty Right Arm against Pharaoh and brought him to his knees. He judged Mitsrayim until the land and the people were completely broken.

YHWH then instructed Moshe to tell the people:

READER #1

"On the tenth day of this month each one of them is to take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the beings, according to each man's need you make you count for the lamb.

READER #2

Let the lamb be a perfect one, a year old male. Take it from the sheep or from the goats.

And you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. then all the assembly of the congregation of Yisrael shall kill it between the evenings.

And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorpost and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

READER #3

And they shall eat the flesh on that night, roasted in fire, its head with its legs, and its inward parts.

And do not leave any of it until morning, and what remains of it until morning you are to burn with fire.

LEADER

And this is how you are to eat it: your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. And you shall eat it in haste.”

IT IS THE PASSOVER/PESACH OF YHWH.

We also begin tonight the observance of Chag Matzot, the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which is an integral part of Pesach and yet it is separate and speaks its own unique message to us. By eating Matzah for 7 days, we remember the initial event that happened so long ago.

READER #1

Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. Indeed on the first day you cause leaven to cease from your houses. For whoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that being shall be cut off from Yisrael.

READER #2

And on the first day is a set-apart gathering, and the seventh day you have a set-apart gathering. No work at all is done on them, only that which is eaten by every being, that alone is prepared by you.

READER #3

And you shall guard the Festival of Matzot, for on this same day I brought your divisions out of the land of Mitsrayim. And you shall guard this day throughout your generations, and everlasting law.

LEADER

[Mattithyahu 16:6-7, 11-12] And Y'shua said to them, Mind! And beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees. And they reasoned among themselves, saying, it is because we brought no bread! ... How is it that you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread, but beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees? Then they understood that He did not say to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the teachings of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.

CONGREGATION-

[1 Corinthians 5:6-8] Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the entire lump? Therefore cleanse out the old leaven, so that you are a new lump, as you are unleavened. For also Messiah our Pesach was slaughtered for us. So then let us celebrate the Feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of evil and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

LEADER

YHWH brought Yisrael out, led them through the wilderness, revealed His Presence at Har Sinai, and gave to them the Torah. He enabled them to build the Tabernacle and established a Priesthood to serve Him. Neither their shoes nor their clothes were worn out. He fed them with manna, gave them water from the Rock, defeated their enemies before them and brought them into Eretz Yisrael. YHWH did what He promised to Yisrael then. He will do what He has promised to us NOW.

READER #1

For many generations, the descendants of the House of Yisrael have lived unknowingly in Exile.

We have become slaves of religious institutions, wasting away our days of labor on systems of man's pride, and constructing buildings to honor the name of denominations.

READER #2

We have raised our children to think of themselves as loyal adherents to Pharaoh's teachings.

We have given of our resources to aid in his cause.

READER #3

We have traded our identity as Yisrael to become accepted by competitors for the Covenant YHWH gave to Avraham.

We have become oppressed, afflicted in our soul, and angered by the failure of Pharaoh's system to take care of us.

CONGREGATION

We have begun to cry for freedom, for deliverance, and for a return to the days of peace and happiness experienced long ago. We are tired of Mitsrayim, of the Exile even in this abundant and prosperous land and we now yearn for the Land of our Fathers. We are being drawn to our Root, to our Fathers, to our lineage, to our real identity, and most importantly, to TRUTH!

We desire that Heaven hear us, breaking the boundaries that limit us, and that YHWH send our Moshiach to lead us HOME, where our inward spirit is leading us.

Revelation 18:4 "And I heard another voice from the heaven saying, 'Come out of her, My people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues.' "

LEADER

YHWH has heard our cry and is now awakening us to look for our Deliverer, Y'shua Messiah, Who will demonstrate the Mighty Right Arm of YHWH and bring us out of Exile. We are not able to return to days of peace and happiness here but rather we have the promise of the Land; Eretz Yisrael.

We must cease looking to the false memories of a pleasant past and begin now to prepare ourselves for a coming deliverance; a Greater Exodus. This meal tonight is part of that process. The observance of this meal is to remember that First Pesach. It is also the beginning of the Deliverance of Am Yisrael from our current Exile. **Tonight we eat, we remember, and we prepare our hearts to go home.**

CONGREGATION

Yirmeyahu [Jeremiah] 16:14-15 "Therefore see, the days are coming," declares YHWH, "when it is no longer said, 'YHWH lives Who brought up the children of

Yisrael from the land of Mitsrayim, ' but, ' YHWH lives Who brought the children of Yisrael from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had driven them.' For I shall bring them back into their land I gave to their fathers."

16:19-21 "O YHWH, my strength and my stronghold and my refuge, in the day of distress the nations shall come to You from the ends of the earth and say, 'Our fathers have inherited only falsehood, futility, and there is no value in them'. Would a man make mighty ones for himself, which are not mighty ones? Therefore see, I am causing them to know, this time I cause them to know My Hand and My Might. And they shall know that My Name is YHWH!"

WE KINDLE THE LIGHTS OF PESACH

Mother of Yisrael

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam asher kidshanu bidevaro uvishmo anakhnu madlikim haneyrot shel yom tov....

CONGREGATION

Blessed are You, YHWH our Elohim, King of the universe, Who has set us apart by His Word, and in Whose Name we light the festival lights...

LEADER

Yeshayahu [Isaiah] 60:1-3 "Arise, shine, for you light has come! And the esteem of YHWH has risen upon you. For look, darkness covers the earth, and thick darkness the peoples. But YHWH arises over you, and His esteem is seen upon you. And the gentiles shall come to your light, and the sovereigns to the brightness of your rising."

CONGREGATION

Yochanan [John] 8:12 "Therefore Y'shua spoke to them again, saying, 'I am the Light of the World. He who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but possess the light of life.' "

1 Yochanan [1 John] 1:6-7 "If we say that we have fellowship with Him and walk in darkness, we lie and are not doing the Truth. But if we walk in the Light as He is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Y'shua Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin."

LEADER

Mattiyyahu [Matthew] 5:14-16 "You are the Light of the World. It is impossible for a city to be hidden on a mountain. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lamp stand, and it shines to all those in the house. Let your light so shine before men, so that they see our good works and praise your Father Who is in Heaven."

CONGREGATION

As we observe, celebrate, and remember, we drink of the Fruit of the Vine, to acknowledge the Covenant we have been given. We hear again YHWH's Word to Moshe, *"Now see what I shall do..."*

I Will bring you out from under the burdens of the Mitsrites...

I Will deliver you from their enslaving...

I Will redeem you with an outstretched arm...

I Will take you as My People and I shall be your Elohim.

THE CUP OF SANCTIFICATION

[We now pour the first of four cups tonight.]

LEADER

Our preparation must include His cleansing and becoming Set Apart unto YHWH [Kadosh l' YHWH]. We hear the ancient commandment given to our fathers in the wilderness:

B'midbar 20:7-8 "And you shall set yourselves apart, and shall be set apart, for I am YHWH your Elohim, and you shall guard My laws and do them. I am YHWH, Who sets you apart."

We drink this cup declaring our willingness to be Set Apart.

CONGREGATION

Yehezqel 36:24-25 "And I shall take you from among the gentiles, and I shall gather you out of all lands, and I shall bring you into our own land. And I shall sprinkle clean

water on you, and you shall be clean- from all you filthiness, and from all your idols I cleanse you."

LEADER

Shemot 12:13 "And the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And When I see the blood, I shall pass over you, and let the plague not come on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Mitsrayim."

CONGEGATION

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam borey p'ri hagafen...

Blessed are You YHWH our Elohim, King of the universe Who creates the fruit of the Vine...

[Drink the Cup of Sanctification]

WASHING OF HANDS

READER #1

On the night that Y'shua was betrayed, He took a basin of water and washed the feet of His disciples. He taught His disciples that they should not compete with each other for position and prominence.

READER #2

He is teaching us that we should wash one another. We are to consider others and their needs before our own, rejoicing when they grow and mature in Him.

READER #3

Our preparation for the coming Greater Exodus requires that we not only keep ourselves clean, but that we wash one another through prayers and intercessions and by encouraging each other to live righteously.

LEADER

Yochanan 13:13-16 "You call Me Teacher and Master, and you say well, for I am. Then if I, Master and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I gave you an example, that you should as I have done to you. Truly, truly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master, nor is an emissary greater than he who sent him."

CONGREGATION

Tehillim 24:3 "Who shall go up into the mountain of YHWH? And who does stand in His set apart place? He who has innocent hands and a clean heart..."

[Let us serve one another, cleansing our fellow believer and offer a prayer of favor and blessing as we pour water over his or her hands.]

Song- "Who May Ascend?"

KARPAS

LEADER

Pesach is celebrated as part of the Spring time Feasts. During this season we see the green life springing up again from the ground. Among those life giving plants rising from dormant sleep is the karpas. This sprig of parsley represents hope of new life, which is created by and sustained by YHWH, our Elohim.

READER #1

The karpas is a reminder of the hyssop used to apply the blood of the lamb to the doorposts in Mitsrayim.

READER #2

It was also used to provide the soured wine mixture to Y'shua when He hung on the tree for us.

READER #3

David said, *"Purge me with hyssop and I shall be clean..."*

LEADER

Our ancient ancestors groaned and cried out in the bitterness of their toils in slavery. The saltiness of their tears was tasted in their mouths as they streamed down their faces. This painful experience took away all desire to remain in bondage, breaking their hearts,

and causing them to yearn for freedom and deliverance.

CONGREGATION

Tonight we weep for the bitterness of our separation from our heritage and from the Covenant that our fathers abandoned. We weep, seeking return and restoration. We weep at the thought of the years we have spent laboring for what will not last and for those we love who are yet doing the same. We weep for the inheritance that our fathers abandoned in favor of the ways of the nations around them. We weep for our toil, our loss, and for our desire to go home. We weep for the fact that we have lost our connection to our past and to our ancestry.

READER #1

Yeshayahu 63:16 "For You are our Father, though Avraham does not know us, and Yisrael does not recognize us. You, O YHWH, are our Father, our Redeemer - Your Name is from of old."

READER #2

Father Avraham, don't you know us? Don't you recognize who we are? Though we have become a mixed people, and we have lost among the nations, we know that we come from you.

READER #3

We can't prove our bloodline nor our lineage, but we have your heart. We are willing to leave everything and everyone to come to the Land where our Father is leading. Our desire is for the same Kingdom and the same Promises that you looked for.

CONGREGATION

Yirmeyahu 50:4-5 "In those days and at that time," declares YHWH, "the children of Yisrael shall come, they and the children of Yehudah together, weeping as they come, and seek YHWH their Elohim. They shall ask the way to Tsiyon, their faces toward it, 'Come and let us join ourselves to YHWH, in an everlasting Covenant, never to be forgotten.'"

LEADER

Yirmeyahu 31:9 "With weeping they shall come, and with their prayers I bring them. I shall make them walk by rivers of waters, in a straight way in which they do not stumble. For I shall be a Father to Yisrael, and Ephraim - he is My first-born."

CONGREGATION

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam borey p'ri ha'adamah...

Blessed are You YHWH our Elohim, King of the universe Who creates the fruit of the Earth...

[We remember and we eat the karpas dipped in salty water]

LEADER

During our journey from living in Mitsrayim to building our homes in Eretz Yisrael, we have learned the value of asking questions. It is when we learn to ask the best questions that we obtain the best answers. It is part of our learning and growing. We also teach this skill to our children, who are a vital part of this experience and remembrance tonight.

READER #1

And it shall be when you come into the land which YHWH gives you, as He promised, that you shall guard this service.

READER #2

And it shall be, when your children say to you, "What does this service mean to you?"

READER #3

...then you shall say, "It is the Pesach slaughtering of YHWH, Who passed over the houses of the children of Yisrael in Mitsrayim when He smote the Mitsrites and delivered our households."

CHILD'S QUESTIONS:

On all other nights we eat either leavened bread or matzah.

On this night, why do we eat only matzah?

On all other nights eat herbs of any kind.

On this night, why do we eat only bitter herbs?

On all other nights, we do not even dip once.

On this night, why do we dip twice?

THE MATZAH

LEADER

Our fathers left Mitsrayim in such haste that their bread dough did not have time to rise. They ate unleavened bread, speaking of their new found deliverance and the beginnings of maturity.

Tonight we eat Matzah to recognize Y'shua our Messiah, Who will deliver us and cause us to walk in His Maturity.

[One at each table holds up the Matzah for all to see]

READER #1

The Messiah we look for bears the scars of stripes.

CONGREGATION

Yeshayahu 53:5 "...by His stripes we are healed..."

READER #2

The Messiah we look for bears the scars of being pierced.

READER #3

Yeshayahu 53:5 "...But He was pierced for our transgressions..."

CONGREGATION

Zekaryah 12:10 "...And they shall look on Me whom they pierced and they shall mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son..."

LEADER

We now break the Matzah in half, wrapping one half in a napkin and laying it aside. Let us take the portion that remains, which speaks of the Messiah that has been revealed to us thus far, and eat of that revelation.

READER #1

Yochanan 1:10 "He was in the world, and the world came to be through Him, and the world did not know Him."

READER #2

11-12 "He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the authority to become children of Elohim, to those believing in His Name."

CONGREGATION

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam hamoetzi lechem min ha'aretz...

Blessed are You YHWH our Elohim, King of the universe Who brings forth Bread from the Earth...

[Eat the Matzah]

The remaining portion, the Afikomen, that we wrapped in a cloth and set aside, will be revealed to us later. Afikomen is a strange word to us, as it is not from the Hebrew, but rather a Greek term, normally used to suggest the idea of dessert. It is more perfectly translated as I will come into being or I will come suddenly.

He Who was bruised and beaten with stripes has come and will come again; suddenly, which power and glory.

THE BITTER HERBS

READER#3

Our fathers wept in bitter toil and struggle while in Mitsrayim. Many died in their forced labor to build Pharaoh's cities and monuments.

READER #1

Shemot 12:11 "So they set slave masters over them to afflict them with their burdens and they built for Pharaoh supply cities, Pithom and Ra'amses."

READER #2

Shemot 12:12-13 "But the more they afflicted them, the more they increased and grew, and they were in dread of the Children of Yisrael. And the Mitsrites made the Children of Yisrael serve with harshness,..."

READER #3

Shemot 12:14 "...and they made their lives bitter with hard bondage, in mortar, and in brick, and in all kinds of work in the field, all their work which they made them do was with harshness."

LEADER

In the coming of the Greater Exodus, we weep because of the bitter judgments that must come in order for us to return. We know that the footsteps of the Messiah are also known as **Ya'acov's Trouble**. The next days are not easy, but yet they must be endured.

CONGREGATION

Tsephanyah 1:14 "Near is the great day of YHWH, near and hurrying greatly, the noise of the day of YHWH. Let the mighty man then bitterly cry out!"

READER #1

Mattithyahu 24:17-18 "Let him who is on the house top not come down to take whatever out of his house. And let him who is in the field not turn back to get his garments."

READER #2

24:19-20 "And woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing in those days! And pray that your flight does not take place in winter or on the Shabbat."

READER #3

24:21-22 "For then there shall be great distress, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And if those days were not shortened, no flesh would be saved, but for the sake of the chosen ones those days shall be shortened."

LEADER

Yehezqel 21:6-7 "And you, son of man, sigh with a breaking of loins, and sigh with bitterness before their eyes. And it shall be when they say to you, 'Why are you sighing?' that you shall say, 'Because of the report that is coming. And every heart shall melt, and all hands shall go limp, and every spirit become faint, and all knees be weak as water. See, it is coming, and it shall be,' declares the Master YHWH."

And so tonight, we scoop some maror/bitterness onto a piece of matzah, as our ancestors scooped the mortar for Pharaoh, and taste again the bitterness of hardship and slavery. We let the bitter herb bring tears to our eyes to identify with their sorrows and to weep for the bitter days that are yet ahead for us.

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam asher kidshanu bidevaro v'tzivanu al akhilat maror...

CONGREGATION

Blessed are You YHWH our Elohim, King of the universe, Who sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us to observe the eating of bitter herbs.

[We eat Matzah with the bitter herbs]

CHAROSET

LEADER

We now eat again the bitter herbs but mixed with the sweetness of Charoset. YHWH made bitter waters sweet for our fathers. We will know the sweetness of redemption and restoration but will also mourn the bitterness of our sinful pasts.

CONGREGATION

Shemot 12:14 "And this day shall become to you a remembrance. And you shall celebrate it as a festival to YHWH throughout your generations - celebrate it as a festival, an everlasting law."

Shemot 12:36 "And YHWH gave the people favor in the eyes of the Mitsrites, so that they gave them what they asked, and they plundered the Mitsrites."

READER #1

Yehezqel 20:41 "As a sweet fragrance I shall accept you when I bring you out from the peoples. And I shall gather you out of the lands where you have been scattered. And I shall be set apart in you before the gentiles."

READER #2

20:42 "And you shall know that I am YHWH, when I bring you into the land of Yisrael, into the land for which I lifted My Hand in an oath to give to your fathers."

READER #3

20:43 "And there you shall remember your ways and your deeds with which you were defiled. And you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight because of all the evils that you did."

CONGREGATION

20:44 "And you shall know that I am YHWH, when I have dealt with you for My Name's sake, not according to your evil ways nor according to your corrupt deeds, O House of Yisrael," declares the Master YHWH.' "

LEADER

Yeshayahu 43:2 "When you pass through the waters, I am with you; and through rivers, they do not overflow you. When you walk through fire, you are not scorched, and a flame does not burn you."

[Let us eat the bitter herbs mixed with charoset]

CUP OF PLAGUES

LEADER

Our fathers saw the wrathful hand of YHWH's judgment on Mitsrayim that ultimately brought about their liberty and release from captivity. Nine plagues ravaged Pharaoh and his people before he relinquished his hold on Yisrael.

CONGREGATION

Shemot 3:19-20 "But I know that the sovereign of Mitsrayim is not going to let you go, not even by a strong hand. And I shall stretch out My Hand and strike Mitsrayim with

all My wonders which I shall do in its midst. And after that he shall let you go.”

READER #1

We understand that likewise Judgment will come upon the lands of our Exile for the sins these nations have committed.

READER #2

We also understand that the nations of the world will determine to stand in battle against our brother Yehudah and seek to take the city of Yerushalayim [Jerusalem] for themselves.

READER #3

The Book of Y'shua's Revelation describes for us the coming judgments to be poured out upon the nations that will ultimately result in Yisrael being returned to the Land of their/our inheritance. May YHWH grant to us endurance and His grace as they come.

[We take a piece of Matzah and dip wine from our glass onto it as we recite the plagues. We remember that Messiah took our plagues for us.]

LEADER ANNOUNCES, CONGREGATION REPEATS [3 x each.]

BLOOD

FROGS

LICE

WILD BEASTS

CATTLE DISEASE

BOILS

HAIL

LOCUSTS

DARKNESS

DEATH OF THE FIRSTBORN

LEADER:

In our day, we will once again witness the Mighty Hand of YHWH demonstrating His

wrath on the Nations. In the Book of Revelation, Yochanan details for us those coming events and their devastation. We will witness:

The coming conqueror, War, Famine, Death, Patience, Natural Disasters, Silence in Heaven

Hail and Fire mixed with Blood, Third of Seas become Blood, Wormwood, Heavens darkened

Scorpion like Locusts, Warriors from the Euphrates who bring devastation, Transferring of the Earth's Sovereignty, Grievous sores, Seas become Blood, Rivers become Blood, Men burnt with Fire, Painful Darkness, Euphrates Dried, and the Great Earthquake.

CONGREGATION

D'varim 26:8 "And YHWH brought us out of Mitsrayim with a strong hand and with an outstretched arm, with great fear and with signs and wonders."

READER #1

"On that night I shall pass through Mitsrayim..."

CONGREGATION

I, and not a angel.

READER #2

and strike down every firstborn...both men and animals...

CONGREGATION

I, and not a seraph.

READER #3

And I will bring judgment of all the gods of Mitsrayim."

CONGREGATION

I, and not a messenger.

LEADER

I AM YHWH

CONGREGATION

I Myself and none other.

DAYENU!!

Leader reads and Congregation responds “Dayenu”

If He had brought us out from Mitsrayim, and had not carried out judgments against them

Dayenu!

If He had carried out judgments against them, and not against their idols

Dayenu!

If He had destroyed their idols, and had not smitten their first-born

Dayenu!

If He had smitten their first-born, and had not given us their wealth

Dayenu!

If He had given us their wealth, and had not split the sea for us

Dayenu!

If He had split the sea for us, and had not taken us through it on dry land

Dayenu!

If He had taken us through the sea on dry land, and had not drowned our oppressors in it

Dayenu!

If He had drowned our oppressors in it, and had not supplied our needs in the desert for forty years

Dayenu, it would have sufficed us!

If He had supplied our needs in the desert for forty years, and had not fed us the manna Dayenu!

If He had fed us the manna, and had not given us the Shabbat

Dayenu!

If He had given us the Shabbat, and had not brought us before Mount Sinai

Dayenu!

If He had brought us before Mount Sinai, and had not given us the Torah

Dayenu!

If He had given us the Torah, and had not brought us into the land of Yisrael

Dayenu!

If He had brought us into the land of Yisrael, and had not built for us the Temple

Dayenu!

LEADER

But YHWH our Elohim, the Everlasting Set Apart One, Blessed Be He, has indeed provided all these blessings for our ancestors and now for us. Not only these, but also many more!

BARUCH ATAH YHWH ELOHIM!!

CONGREGATION

Blessed are You YHWH, for You have, in mercy supplied all our needs, You have given us Your
Mashiach, forgiveness of our sins, life more abundant, and life everlasting. Halleluyah!

[Let us fill our cups!]

CONGREGATION

Baruch atah YHWH, Eloheynu Melech ha'olam, boray pre hagafen!

Blessed are You, YHWH our Elohim, King of the Universe, Who creates the fruit of the Vine.

CONGREGATION

Baruch atah YHWH Eloheynu Melech HaOlam hamoetzi lechem min ha'aretz...

READER #1

He is both Suffering Servant and Coming King.

READER #2

He is Messiah Son of Yosef and Messiah Son of David

READER #3

He is Messiah and He is the Living Torah

CONGREGATION

He is the Deliverer of Yisrael and He is Judge of all the Nations!

READER#1

He is Y'shua HaMoshiach of Yisrael, the Living Word of Elohim, the Walking, Talking Torah Scroll, Whom Moshe and the Prophets declared, Who hung on a tree to bleed and die as our Pesach Lamb, Who restores us to our Priesthood, Who heals, forgives, restores, and renews His Covenant with all those who will believe and trust Him.

READER #2

He is the Covering Sacrifice for Adam and Chavah. He is Noach's Ark of safety in the time of worldwide judgment. He is the Friend and Covenant of Avraham. He is the Prosperity and Blessing of Yitzchak. He is Ya'acov's Ladder. He wears Yosef's coat of many colors and holds the Sovereign's Scepter of Yehudah. He's the Rod of Moshe that

parts the waters and brings water from the Rock. He is in fact that very same Rock! He's Aharon's Rod that budded.

READER #3

He's the Living Manna that can feed a nation in the Wilderness. He is the Torah written and examined for all to see, know, and obey. He is David's Sling, Sword, and Shield, Shimson's Strength, Eliyahu's Mantle, a Chariot of Fire and a Whirlwind of Resurrection Power. He is Shelomoh's Temple, Yirmeyahu's Title Deed, a Coal of Fire on Yeshayahu's tongue, sitting on the Chariot in Yehezqel's vision.

LEADER

He has broke the fear and bondage of death and the grave. He has given us the Name of the Father and taught us to walk again in the beauty of His Torah. He gives power to overcome to all who love Him and obey His commandments. Blessed be Y'shua our Messiah Who has done all these things for us.

CONGREGATION

Revelation 14:12 "Here is the endurance of the set apart ones, here are those guarding the commands of Elohim and the belief of Yshua."

LEADER

Revelation 22:12-14 "And see, I am coming speedily, and My reward is with Me, to give to each according to his work."

I am the Aleph and the Tav, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.

LEADER

We again fill our cups and prepare to rejoice in our great salvation and deliverance.

READER #1

Revelation 5:9-10 "And they sang a renewed song, saying, 'You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals, because You were slain, and have redeemed us to Elohim by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and made us sovereigns and priests to our Elohim, and we shall reign upon the Earth.'"

READER #2

Luke 22:20 "...This cup is the Renewed Covenant in My Blood which is shed for you."

READER #3

Revelation 22:14 "Blessed are those doing His commands, so that the authority shall be theirs unto the tree of life, to enter through the gates of the city..."

LEADER

Shemot 6:6 "Say therefore to the Children of Yisrael...I shall redeem you with an outstretched arm..."

CONGREGATION

Yeshayahu 59:1 "Look, the Hand of YHWH has not become too short to save, nor ear too heavy to hear."

59:16 "And He saw that there was no man, and was astonished that there was no intercessor. So His own Arm saved for Him, and His Righteousness upheld Him."

LEADER

We have been redeemed to enter in! Let us lift our cup and rejoice in our great Redemption!

CONGREGATION

ELIYAHU HANAVI

LEADER

It is understood that before the Day of YHWH, Eliyahu HaNavi will come again to us and restore us back to the Patriarchs; Avraham, Yitzchak, and Ya'acov. Could it be that He has come to lead us tonight?

CONGREGATION

Malachi 4:5-6 "See I am sending you Eliyahu the prophet before the coming of the great and awesome day of YHWH. And he shall turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the Earth with utter destruction."

[Someone check the door!]

THE CUP OF JOY [THE CUP OF EXPECTATION]

LEADER

After Y'shua gave the third cup to His disciples, they sang a hymn and left to go to the Mt. of Olives, never drinking the fourth cup. That cup speaks of the Kingdom that is yet to come.

READER #1

Mattithyahu 26:29 "But this I say to you, I shall certainly not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on till that day when I drink it anew with you in the reign of My Father."

READER #2

But tonight we drink joyfully of this cup in expectation of the coming of the Kingdom of our Messiah Y'shua and of the Restoration of Yisrael.

READER #3

Revelation 22:17 "And the Spirit and the Bride say, 'Come!' And he who hears, let him say, 'Come!' And he who desires it, take the water of life without paying!..." Verse 20 "He that bears witness of these matters says, "Yea, I am coming speedily." Amen. Yea, come, Master Y'shua!"
