

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# Opening Adoration






# Psalm 100

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# Signs of Messiah's Return

Genesis 14

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- 1And it came to be in the days of Amraphel sovereign of Shin'ar, Aryok sovereign of Ellasar, Kedorla'omer sovereign of Eylam, and Tid'al sovereign of Goyim,
- 2that they fought against Bera sovereign of Sedom, Birsha sovereign of Amorah, Shinab sovereign of Admah, Shem'ĕber sovereign of Tseboyim, and the sovereign of Bela, that is Tso'ar.
- 3All these joined together in the Valley of Siddim, that is the Salt Sea.
- 4Twelve years they served Kedorla'omer, and in the thirteenth year they rebelled.
- 5And in the fourteenth year Kedorla'omer and the sovereigns that were with him came and smote the Repha'im in Ashteroth Qarnayim, and the Zuzim in Ḥam, and the Ěmites in Shawĕh Qiryathayim,
- 6and the Horites in their mountain of Sĕ'ir, as far as Ěl Paran, which is by the wilderness.

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- 7And they turned back and came to En Mishpat, that is Qadesh, and smote all the country of the Amaleqites, and also the Amorites who dwelt in Hatsetson Tamar.
- 8And the sovereign of Sedom, and the sovereign of Amorah, and the sovereign of Admah, and the sovereign of Tseboyim, and the sovereign of Bela, that is Tso'ar, went out and joined together in battle in the Valley of Siddim,
- 9against Kedorla'omer sovereign of Eylam, and Tid'al sovereign of Goyim, and Amraphel sovereign of Shin'ar, and Aryok sovereign of Ellasar four sovereigns against five.
- 10And the Valley of Siddim had many tar pits. And the sovereigns of Sedom and Amorah fled and fell there, and the remainder fled to the mountains.
- 11And they took all the goods of Sedom and Amorah, and all their food, and went away.
- 12And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son who dwelt in Sedom, and his goods, and left.

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- 13And one who had escaped came and informed Abram the Hebrew, for he dwelt by the terebinth trees of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshkol and brother of Aner, and they had a covenant with Abram.
- 14And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his three hundred and eighteen trained servants who were born in his own house, and went in pursuit as far as Dan.
- 15And he and his servants divided against them by night, and smote them and pursued them as far as Ḥoḇah, which is on the left of Damascus.
- 16So he brought back all the goods, and also brought back his brother Lot and his goods, as well as the women and the people.
- 17And after his return from the defeat of Kedorla'omer and the sovereigns who were with him, the sovereign of Sedom came out to meet him at the Valley of Shaweh, that is, the Sovereign's Valley.
- 18And Malkitsedeq sovereign of Shalem brought out bread and wine. Now he was the priest of the Most High El.

- 19And he blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram of the Most High El, Possessor of the heavens and earth.
- 20"And blessed be the Most High El who has delivered your enemies into your hand." And he gave him a tenth of all.
- 21And the sovereign of Sedom said to Abram, "Give me the people, and take the goods for yourself."
- 22But Abram said to the sovereign of Sedom, "I have lifted my hand to יהוה, the Most High El, the Possessor of the heavens and earth,
- 23not to take a thread or a sandal strap or whatever is yours, lest you should say, 'I have made Abram rich,'
- 24except only what the young men have eaten, and the portion of the men who went with me: Aner, Eshkol, and Mamre. Let them take their portion."







### What will we talk about today?



**Genesis 14:1** And it came about in the days of Amraphel king of Shinar, Arioch king of Ellasar, Chedorlaomer king of Elam, and Tidal king of Goiim, **2** that they made war with Bera king of Sodom, and with Birsha king of Gomorrah, Shinab king of Admah, and Shemeber king of Zeboiim, and the king of Bela (that is, Zoar).



Chedorlaomer's Elamite empire, situated in what is now southwest Iran,

Shinar. The Genesis Apocryphon 21.23 and Targum Onkelos both read "Babylon."

The kingdom Ellasar most likely represents the Mesopotamian kingdom of Larsa, which emerged as a power player for a short window during the early second millennium. Arioch, king of Ellasar, was a name common in north Mesopotamia.


Finally, there is "Tidal, king of Goiim." The polity here is ambiguous (the Hebrew Goiim meaning "nations" or "peoples"), but Tidal is a recognized Hittite name, Tudhalia. Several Hittite rulers bore this name. The Hittite empire was based in modern-day Turkey and was comprised of numerous tribes and peoples, thus befitting the name "king of nations" or "peoples."

#### Same Nations

**Ezekiel 38:1** And the word of the LORD came to me saying, **2** "Son of man, set your face toward Gog of the land of **Magog**, the prince of Rosh, **Meshech and Tubal**, and prophesy against him **3** and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I am against you, O Gog, prince of Rosh, Meshech and Tubal. **4** "I will turn you about and put hooks into your jaws, and I will bring you out, and all your army, horses and horsemen, all of them splendidly attired, a great company with buckler and shield, all of them wielding swords; **5 Persia**, **Ethiopia** and **Put** with them, all of them with shield and helmet; **6 Gomer** with all its troops; **Beth-togarmah** from the remote parts of the north with all its troops — many peoples with you.

#### Ezek 38 Coalition

- **1.Magog**: According to first-century Jewish historian Josephus, the land of Magog was inhabited by the Scythians. The Scythians lived throughout **Central Asia**, indicating its identity is associated with nations today such as **Kazakhstan**, **Kirghizia**, **Uzbekistan**, **Turkmenistan**, and **Tajikistan**. Some also include **Afghanistan** in this group.
- **2.Rosh**: Rosh is a part of the north **Syria** (38:6, 15; 39:2).
- 3.Meshek (or Meshech) and Tubal: Noted together in this passage, this area is located in part of modern-day Turkey.
- 4.Persia: This is the land of modern Iran.
- **5.Cush (or Ethiopia)**: This land, often translated as Ethiopia, is not the same as modern Ethiopia. It represented the land south of **Egypt**. Today, this nation is **Sudan**.
- **6.Put**: Also translated in some versions as Libya, this land is still known as **Libya** today.
- **7.Gomer**: Part of modern **Turkey**.
- 8.Beth Togarmah: Part of modern Turkey.

The founder of the Mermnad dysnasty, Gyges (ca. 685–547 B.C.), attempted to expand his kingdom to the Aegean coast, while struggling to repel the invasions of the Cimmerians. Gyges is mentioned in an Assyrian treaty as "Guggu of Ludu," and it is possible that Gyges is to be identified as the "Gog" spoken of in Ezekiel 38–39.

MA'GOG (magog; "region of Gog"). Mentioned in Gen. 10:2; 1 Chron. 1:5 as the second son of Japheth, but understood by some to be the name of a people. Magog is associated with Gomer in Genesis, with Gog in Ezekiel (38:2; 39:6, cf. v. 1). Gog is described by the prophet as belonging to "the land of Magog," the situation of which is defined by its proximity to the isles of the Aegean. It is clear that Lydia is meant, and that by Magog we must understand "the land of Gog." Scholars have sought to identify Gog with Gugu (Gyges), king of Lydia, and with Gagaia of the Amarna Letters. The New Unger's Bible Dictionary, S.V. "MAGOG," 804.

Abraham defeated four kings from the north of Israel after Lot decided to go to Sodom to live and was taken captive there. Abraham defeated these kings with an army of only 318 trained servants and rescued Lot.



**5** Then in the fourteenth year Chodollogomor and the kings who were with him came and cut down the giants who were in Astaroth Karnain and strong nations together with them and the Ommites who were in the city Saue. NETS

**7** And after they had turned back they came to the spring of judgment (this is Kades) and cut down all the rulers of Amalek and the Amorrites who live in Hasasan Thamar.

EN-MISHPAT (En-mish' påt) Place-name meaning "spring of judgment." Another name for Kadesh, where the eastern coalition of kings defeated the Amalekites and Amorites. The location is usually called Kadesh-barnea and identified with the oasis now called ain Hudeirat. Holman Illustrated Bible Dictionary, s.v. "HOLMAN Illustrated Bible Dictionary," paragraph 0.



AMORITES People who occupied part of the promised land and often fought Israel. Their history goes back before 2000 B.C. They took control of the administration of Babylonia for approximately 400 years (2000–1595), their most influential king being Hammurabi (1792–1750). Their descent to Canaan may be traced back to 2100–1800 when their settlement in the hill country helped to set the stage for the revelation of God through Israel. Daniel C. Even though Israel was exiled because of sin and unbelief, she still was not rejected by God. Since the covenant the Lord made with Abraham was unconditional (Gen. 15), his descendants need not fear.

The association of *checed* with "covenant" keeps it from being misunderstood as mere providence or love for all creatures; it applies primarily to God's particular love for His chosen and covenanted people. "Covenant" also stresses the reciprocity of the relationship; but since God's *checed* is ultimately beyond the covenant, it will not ultimately be abandoned, even when the human partner is unfaithful and must be disciplined (<u>lsa. 54:8, 10</u>). Since its final triumph and implementation is eschatological, *checed* can imply **the goal** and end of all salvation-history (<u>Ps. 85:7, 10; 130:7; Mic. 7:20</u>).


The word *Ruts* can signify "running" into somewhere not only in a hostile sense but in order to be united with or hidden by it. For example, the sage confesses that "the name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe" (Prov. 18:10). The goal of "running" may be unspecified while the direction or path is emphasized. So used, *ruts* means to pursue a particular course of action: "I will run the way of thy commandments ..." (Ps. 119:32).






